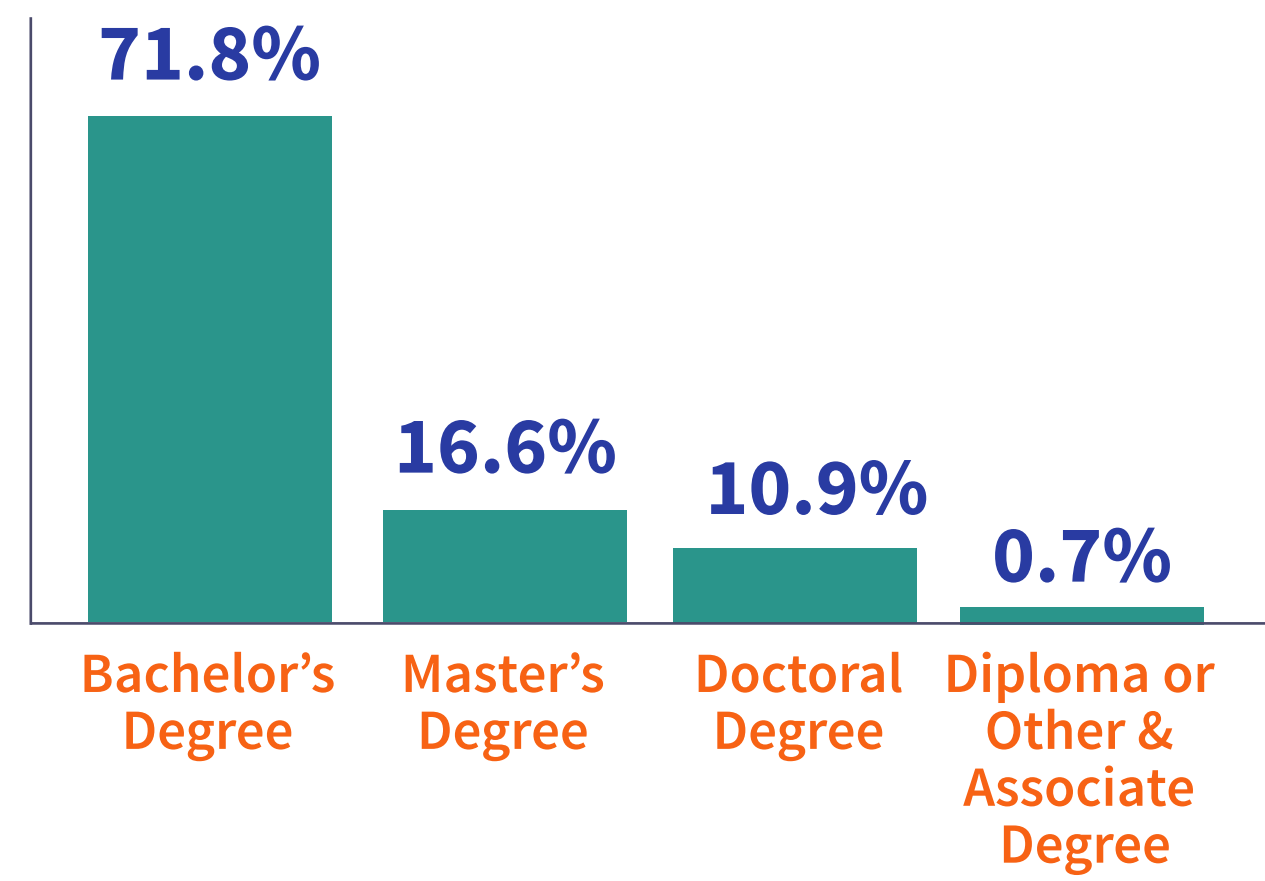


Who is Applying to Graduate Schools and Programs of Public Health?

Highest Degree Earned



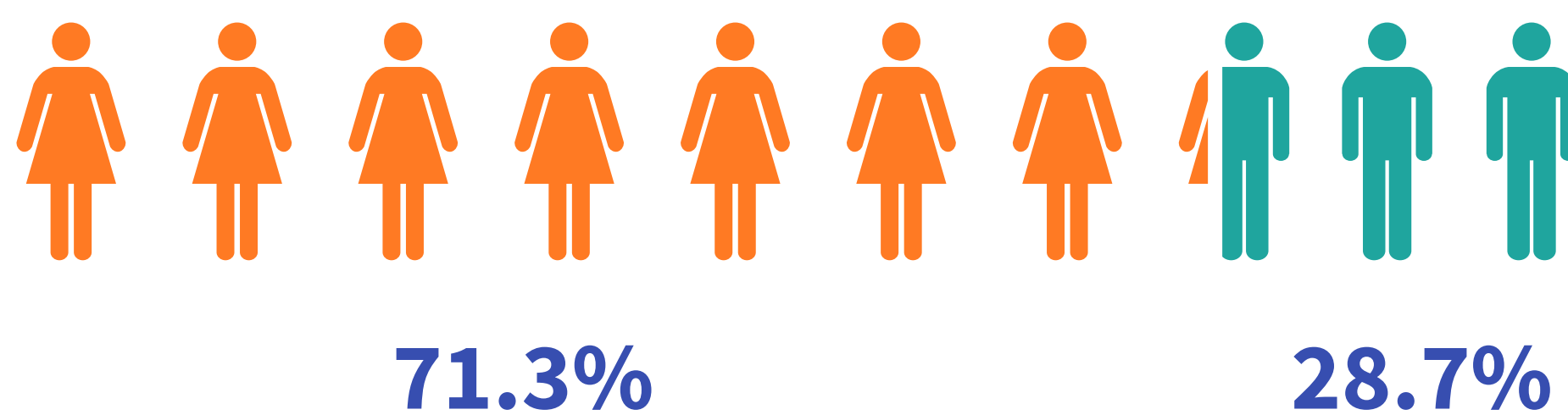
Average GRE



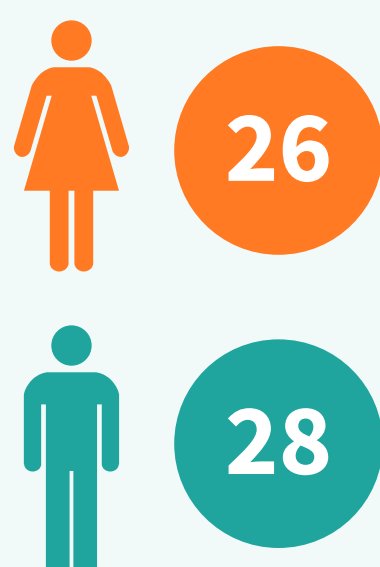
Average GPA



Gender

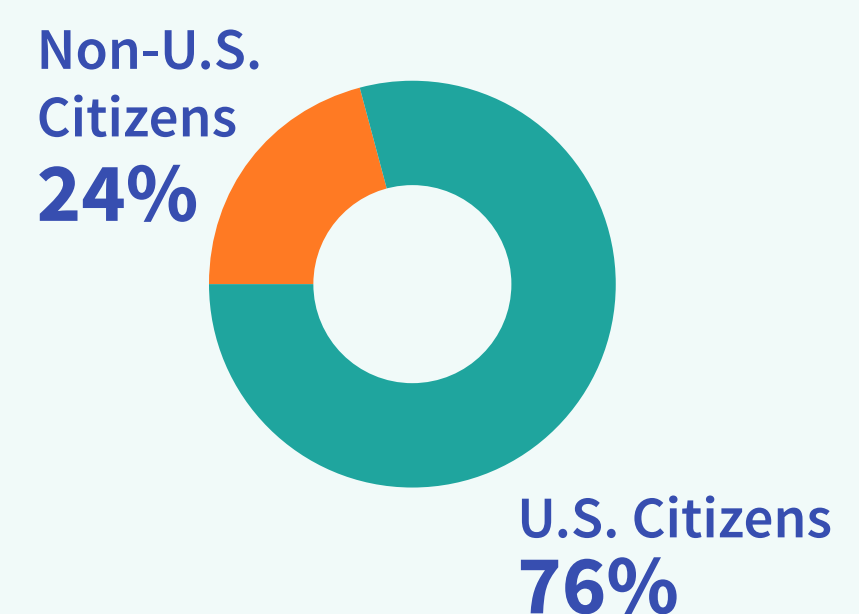


Average Age
